



The thrilling experience for visitors begins with a ride up from the heart of the old town on the fortress funicular railway. Inside, the fortress impresses with a wealth of art-historical attractions: The sumptuous state rooms are among the most beautiful secular Gothic rooms in Europe.

The prison tower can be visited during the Panorama Tour and offers stunning views of the mountains and a chance to see the 'Salzburg Bull', a unique historic organ incorporating horns, which is still sounded several times a day. In recent years, there have been large investments in the design of interactive exhibitions and museums. Furthermore, the fortress also offers an extraordinary exclusive backdrop for events of all types and sizes – ranging from concerts to special celebrations.








The City of Salzburg is ideal for coach groups. Bus Terminal North is situated in Paris-Lodron-Straße (near Mirabell Square), and the Bus Terminal South can be found in Erzabt-Klotz-Straße (Nonntal). These bus stops can only be used to let passengers on and off - afterwards, the bus must leave again immediately. Coach parks can be found near the Autobahn exit Salzburg North, near Hellbrunn and at the P+R Alpenstraße/ Salzburg South.

Bus Terminal South is in Nonntal on the edge of Salzburg old town. The walk to the fortress funicular station to ride up to Hohensalzburg Fortress takes around 15 minutes - across Kajetanerplatz Square, Kaigasse, Kapitelgasse and Kapitelplatz Square. Salzburg has a new online booking system (www.salzburg.info/de/b2b/ gruppenplaner/reisebus) for coaches. Time slots must be booked for guest arrival and departure at the two terminals.



As soon as visitors arrive there's a sense of just how special this 11th century castle really is. Sitting majestically on its throne against the backdrop of the Salzburg mountains, it exercises a magical fascination for visitors. So it's no surprise that the castle has repeatedly been used for films and TV series, not least 'Where Eagles Dare' and 'The Man in the High Castle'. Your clients will find its charm irresistible. Once inside the old castle courtyard, visitors are transported back to another age. Explore the castle interior, the torture chamber and high bell tower with a costumed castle guide!

Alternatively, make your way straight to the grassy hillside and marvel as the birds of prey soar skywards and perform impressive stunts. In addition to the main tours and events, such as the castle tour and the falconry demonstration, there are lots of new trips and features to take guests back in time. The arsenal features interactive stations showing the history of the castle, and a digital multimedia journey back to the Salzburg Peasants' War of 1525/26. Why not hold an event in the castle courtyard, tavern or any of the other truly great venues at the fortress?

THEMED

There are also theme tours for those seeking an alternative to the standard castle tour. One alternative is "Josef Steinwender - The Silent Prisoner", who tells the story of his 22 years of imprisonment at Hohenwerfen Castle. Or there's Barbara Koller, aka "Bärbel the Butcher" or "Schinder-Bärbel", who tells of her fate as the mother of "Jackl the Wizard". Koller was accused of witchcraft, persecuted and imprisoned here.

THEMED EXHIBITION

"The Uprising - Hohenwerfen Castle in the Salzburg Peasants' War of 1525/26"

The peasants' and miners' uprising in Salzburg almost led to the downfall of the Prince-Archbishopric in the 16th century. Those fighting the authorities were particularly successful in the Alpine interior. The rebels even captured Hohenwerfen Castle, and this briefly became a symbol of their triumph.



You can reach the town of Werfen from all directions via the Tauernautobahn (A 10). Coming from the north, take the exit "Pass Luege" and drive along the Salzachtal federal road (B159) further towards the south. After passing through Tenneck village, you will get to Hohenwerfen Castle, which has a car park just off the federal road. Coming from the south, take the autobahn exit "Pfarrwerfen/Werfen" and continue in the direction of Werfen. After approx.

two kilometres, you will reach the car park of Hohenwerfen castle. Note: To travel on Austria's autobahn, you must purchase a vignette. If you want to avoid purchasing a vignette, you can reach Hohenwerfen Castle via the Salzachtal federal road (B 159). Ample free parking available for coaches.

Distance: approx. 40 km south of Salzburg



Mauterndorf Castle is situated in the UNESCO Biosphere Park
Lungau, in the town of Mauterndorf, 1,100 m above sea level.
Thanks to this special location, the castle played a strategically
important role in the Middle Ages, along the trade route over the
Alps. Goods from the south and wealth from the north met here
and even today still give this castle a welcoming exclusivity.
Visitors sense the history in the walls of this old toll castle as
soon as they enter, and soon find themselves on a journey back

to the Middle Ages. Inside the castle, set scenes and figures in historical garb add an impressive new interpretation to this time travel. The highlights include a visit to the 44 m high defensive tower and an exploratory visit to the private apartment of Prince-Archbishop Leonhard von Keutschach, who used to use this castle as a summer residence. This atmosphere in the historic rooms is also an impressive backdrop that is sure to make any event or conference a success.

You can reach the town of Mauterndorf via the Tauernautobahn (A 10), take the exit St. Michael. Then continue on the B 99 until you get to Mauterndorf.

Please note: To travel on Austria's autobahn, you must purchase a vignette. In addition, coming from the north, you will be charged a fee to travel through the Tauerntunnel (between Flachauwinkel-South and Zederhaus) and, coming from the south, to travel through the Katschbergtunnel (between Rennweg and St. Michael). Ample free parking available for coaches. If you want to avoid buying a vignette, take the following route to reach Mauterndorf Castle:

 From the north (city of Salzburg): Salzachtal federal road (B 159) until you get to Bischofshofen, then continue on the B 99 to Radstadt via Obertauern in den Lungau. (approx. 90 minutes)

- From the west (Zell am See): Pinzgauer Straße (B 311) from Zell am See until you get to Bischofshofen, then continue on Katschberg Straße (B 99) to Radstadt via Obertauern in den Lungau. (approx. 95 minutes)
- From the south (Carinthia): From Spittal an der Drau via Katschberg Straße
 (B 99) and Gmünd, Rennweg, St. Michael to Mauerndorf. (approx. 40 minutes)
- From the east (Styria): From Murau to the Murtal federal road (B 96) to Tamsweg, then continue on the Turracher federal road (B 95) to Mauterndorf. (approx. 40 minutes)

Distance: approx. 120 km south of Salzburg

The "KniePASS" entitles you to visit several stations, opening up new perspectives and inviting self-reflection: Are you an adventurer, thinker or visionary? You may be surprised. Coming from the north, take the "Bad Reichenhall - Lofer" exit on the A8 motorway and continue on the main road (B20 and B21) in a south-westerly direction. Immediately after the village of Unken you will reach Fort Kniepass. From the south on the B311 main road, change in Lofer to the B178 towards Bad Reichenhall - Salzburg.

Distance: around 40 km south-west of Salzburg, around 45 km north-east of Zell am See - Kaprun.
